

**INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA OF
USERS WHO FILL OUT THE CONTACT FORM OF MED DEVICE LAB S.C.A.R.L.**
(art. 13 EU Regulation 679/2016)



1. WHO PROCESSES MY DATA?

The Data Controller is **Med Device Lab S.c.a.r.l.** with its registered office at Piazzale Aldo Moro, 5 – 00186, Rome. You can contact the Data Controller via email at info@meddevice lab.it.

2. FOR WHAT PURPOSES ARE MY DATA PROCESSED AND WHY IS THE PROCESSING LEGITIMATE?

PURPOSE	LEGAL BASIS	OBLIGATION TO PROVIDE DATA
Responding to queries or addressing requests sent by the user through the completion of the contact form or by sending an email	The processing is lawful because it is based on the legitimate interest of the Data Controller to communicate with the users of its website in the context of its activities carried out for consortia purposes pursuant to Article 2615-ter of the Civil Code.	For this purpose, you are free not to provide your data, but if you do not provide them, the Data Controller will not be able to respond to your requests.

3. TO WHOM ARE MY DATA COMMUNICATED?

Your data are communicated to:

- Website maintenance personnel who provide IT assistance
- The entity responsible for managing requests/queries

You can request a complete list of recipients of your personal data by writing to the email address info@meddevice lab.it. In any case, your personal data will not be disseminated.

4. ARE MY DATA TRANSFERRED OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION?

Your data are not transferred outside the European Union.

5. HOW LONG ARE MY DATA STORED?

Your personal data will be stored for a period no longer than necessary to achieve the purposes for which they are being processed. For responding to your requests, your data will be stored only for the time necessary to provide you with a response.

6. WILL I BE SUBJECTED TO PROFILING?

Your data will not be used in any way to obtain information about your preferences or behavior, nor will you be subjected to any decision based solely on automated processing of your personal data.

7. WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS?

You have the following rights

- **Right of access to data:** You have the right to obtain confirmation from the Data Controller whether or not personal data concerning you are being processed, and, where that is the case, access to your personal data and related information about the processing.
 - **Right to rectification of data:** You have the right to obtain from the Data Controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you and the right to have incomplete personal data completed, including by means of providing a supplementary statement.
 - **Right to erasure of data:** You have the right to obtain from the Data Controller the erasure of personal data concerning you without undue delay where one of the following grounds applies:
 - the personal data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed;
 - you withdraw consent on which the processing is based, and there is no other legal ground for the processing;
 - you object to the processing and there are no overriding legitimate grounds for the processing;
 - the personal data have been unlawfully processed;
 - the personal data must be erased for compliance with a legal obligation in Union or Member State law to which the Data Controller is subject;
 - the personal data have been collected in relation to the offer of information society services.
 - **Right to restriction of processing:** You have the right to obtain from the Data Controller restriction of processing where one of the following applies:
 - you contest the accuracy of the personal data, for a period enabling the Data Controller to verify the accuracy of the personal data;
 - the processing is unlawful and you oppose the erasure of the personal data and request the restriction of their use instead;
 - the Data Controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of the processing, but they are required by you for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims;
 - you have objected to processing pending the verification of whether the legitimate grounds of the Data Controller override yours.
 - **Right to object to processing:** You have the right to object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to the processing of personal data concerning you unless the Data Controller demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override your interests, rights, and freedoms, or for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims. You also have the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data for direct marketing purposes, including profiling related to such direct marketing.
 - Right not to be subject to **a decision based solely on automated processing**, including profiling, that produces legal effects concerning you or significantly affects you in a similar manner.
- You can exercise your rights by sending a request to the Data Controller's email address info@meddevice lab.it. The Data Controller will respond to you as soon as possible and, in any case, no later than 30 days from your request.

8. HOW CAN I LODGE A COMPLAINT?
